## Study It: Details

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Read the passage we are studying this Sunday at least four times and answer the following questions.

### ➔ Day 1: What does this passage tell me about God?

How are God's nature and character revealed? e.g. holiness, eternity, power, justice, grace, patience, love.

### ➔ Day 2: What does this passage tell me about people?

What does the text reveal about sin and our need for the gospel? What does it tell me about who I have been declared to be in Christ?

### ➔ Day 3: How does this passage point me to the cross?

How does it reference Jesus? How might my answers to the questions above drive me to Christ? How does Jesus bring life and hope to broken sinners like me?

### ➔ Day 4: How does this passage call me to respond?

Faith, obedience, repentance, confession? How does it impact the following areas?

- Personal holiness
- Marriage & family
- Church community
- Missional lifestyle and loving neighbors

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
